This is an introduction to competitive distance riding. All levels of riders are welcome. The event begins Friday night with a lecture on distance riding and early vet in. The ride starts at 9am on Saturday morning. All horses will receive pre, mid and post ride veterinary checks. This is not a timed race, but a judged trail ride. A limited number of stalls and unlimited small paddocks are available on a first come basis. Rough camping is also available on site.

Rules: Safety helmets required for youth, encouraged for all. Dogs are not allowed on trails. Coggins Test required for all horses. UMECRA Rules apply. The ride takes about 2.25 hours at an average pace of 5mph.
